INVITATION TO BID FOR VARIOUS CATHETERIZATION LABORATORY SUPPLIES FOR 2020 USE

SECOND NEGOTIATED PROCUREMENT - TWO (2) FAILED BIDDINGS

REQUEST FOR BEST AND FINAL OFFER

1. The Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center (MMMh & MC), through the SAA 2020-06-1125 Fund, intends to apply the sum of Two Million Fifty Four Thousand Pesos Only (**₱ 2,054,000.00**) being the Approved Budget for the Contract (ABC) to payments under the contract for the project: **Various Catheterization Laboratory Supplies for 2020 use (Second Negotiated Procurement – Two (2) Failed Biddings)**. Proposals received in excess of the ABC shall be automatically rejected at the opening of the financial proposals.
2. The Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center (MMMh & MC), through its Bids and Awards Committee (BAC), now invites technically, legally and financially capable contractors for the mentioned project.
3. The procurement procedure for this project is Negotiated Procurement due to two (2) failed biddings pursuant to Section 53.1 of the Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of Republic Act No. 9184 (RA 9184), otherwise known as the “Government Procurement Reform Act”, including Annex “H” thereof.

The procurement is restricted to Filipino citizens / sole proprietorships, organizations with at least sixty percent (60%) interest or outstanding capital stock belonging to citizens of the Philippines, and to citizens or organizations of a country the laws or regulations of which grant similar rights to privileges to Filipino citizens, pursuant to Republic Act 5183 (RA 5183) and subject to Commonwealth Act 138 (CA 138).

The BAC will engage in negotiations with a sufficient number of contractors to ensure effective competition. The selection of the successful offer shall be based on the best and final offer that will be submitted on a specified date, which could meet the minimum technical specifications.

4. Interested Bidders may obtain further information from the BAC Secretariat at the address given below from Monday to Friday at 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The requirements listed below shall be submitted in sealed envelopes one (1) original and two (2) duplicate copies, marked as Original, Copy 1 and Copy 2 and shall be true copy of the original certified by the bidder or his duly authorized signatory at the **2nd Floor, Board Room, Main Building of MMMH&MC** on **October 20, 2020 at 9:00 AM**.

1. Price Quotation, inclusive of taxes using the attached form;
2. Duly accomplished and signed Technical Specifications using the attached form;

NOTE: The supplier shall indicate the page(s) where the specific technical data in each technical specification can be found and attach these documents referred to with this form.

3. Duly signed Schedule of Requirements using the attached form;
4. Valid and current Certificate of **PhilGEPS Registration and Membership –Platinum**
5. Registration certificate from the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC), Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) for sole proprietorship, or Cooperative Development Authority (CDA) for cooperatives;
6. Valid and current **Mayor's Permit**. In consideration of the limited access to financial institutions, regulatory and other offices, as well as the implementation of government restrictions on transport and travel, Acceptability of the recently expired Mayor's or Business permits and the Official Receipt as proof that the Bidder has applied and paid for the renewal of the permit ; Provided that, the current and valid Mayor's or Business Permit as renewed, will be submitted by the bidder with the LCRB after the award of contract but before payment (GPPB Circular 09-2020)
7. Latest Annual Tax Return filed thru Electronic Filing and Payment Systems (EFPS) and must be duly validated with the tax payments made thereon for the preceding Tax Year be it on a calendar or fiscal year income (per Revenue Regulations 3-2005);
8. Latest Business Tax Return filed thru Electronic Filing and Payment System (EFPS) duly validated with the tax payments made thereon also refers to the Value Added Tax (VAT) or Percentage Tax Returns covering the previous **six (6)** months (per Revenue Regulations 3-2005);

The latest income and business tax returns are those within the last six months preceding the date of bid submission

9. Tax clearance per Executive Order No. 398, Series of 2005 issued by BIR main office Accounts Receivable Monitoring Division (ARMD), as finally reviewed and approved by the BIR pursuant to RR 01-2016 of BIR;
10. Audited financial statements, showing, among others, the Total and Current Assets and Liabilities, stamped "received" by the Bureau of Internal Revenue (BIR) or its duly

accredited and authorized institutions, for the preceding calendar year, which should not be earlier than two (2) years from the date of bid submission;

11. Statement of **ALL** its ongoing government and private contracts, including contracts awarded but not yet started, if any, whether similar or not similar in nature and complexity to the contract to be bid; **and**

Statement of the Bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC) similar to the contract to be bid *within two (2) years from the Submission and Opening of Bids, must be at least twenty-five (25%) of the ABC.*

For this purpose, similar contracts shall refer to various laboratory/ hospital/ radiological/ medical supplies, devices, reagents and test kits.

The two (2) statements required: *Statement of ALL ongoing government and private contracts and Statement of the Bidder's Single Largest Completed Contract (SLCC)* shall indicate for each contract the following **using the attached prescribed BAC Standard Form Nos. 1 and 2:**

- a. Name of contract;
- b. Date of the contract;
- c. Contract duration;
- d. Owner's name and address;
- e. Kinds of Goods;
- f. For Statement of Ongoing Contracts - amount of contract and value of outstanding contracts;
- g. For Statement of SLCC - amount of completed contracts, adjusted by the Bidder to current prices using PSA's consumer price index, if necessary for the purpose of meeting the SLCC requirement;
- h. Date of delivery; and
- i. End-user's acceptance or official receipt or sales invoice for the contract, if completed, which shall be attached to the statements.

Note: *Failure to include an immaterial ongoing contract or failure to disclose complete information in the statement of contracts shall result in the following (GPPB Resolution No. 29-2012 dated 23 November 2012:*

- (a) Disqualification of the bidder for non-compliance with the eligibility requirement under Section 23.1 or 24.1 of the revised IRR.
 - (b) Blacklisting under Section 65.3 (a) or (b) of the revised IRR.
12. The Bidder must submit a computation of its Net Financial Contracting Capacity (NFCC) which must be at least equal to the ABC to be bid, calculated as follows **using the attached prescribed BAC Standard Form No. 3:**

NFCC = [(Current Assets minus Current Liabilities) **(15)**] minus the value of all outstanding or uncompleted portions of the projects under on-going contracts, including awarded contracts yet to be started coinciding with the contract to be bid.

The values of the domestic bidder's current assets and current liabilities shall be based on the latest Audited Financial Statements submitted to the BIR.

OR

If the prospective bidder submits a Committed Line of Credit (CLC), it must be at least equal to ten percent (10%) of the ABC to be bid issued by Universal or Commercial Bank; Provided, that if the same is issued by a foreign Universal or Commercial Bank, it shall be confirmed or authenticated by a local Universal or Commercial Bank.

13. The Omnibus Sworn Statement executed by the Bidder or its duly authorized representative using the attached prescribed format;
14. Duly notarized authority of the signatory, whichever is applicable:
 1. Secretary's Certificate (i.e. Corporation; Joint Venture Agreement); or
 2. Special Power of Attorney (i.e. Sole Proprietor; Partnership)
 3. In case the signatory is the sole proprietor, copy of the DTI Registration Certificate

Acceptability of Unnotarized Omnibus Sworn Statement and Authority of the Signatory subject to compliance therewith after award of contract but before payment, for procurement activities during a State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions declared or being implemented either in the locality of the PE or of the Bidder.(GPPB Resolution 09-2020)

Please use the attached Price Quotation, Technical Specifications, Schedule of Requirements, Omnibus Sworn Statement and Authority of the Signatory Forms.

NOTE: Bidders shall submit their bid proposal on or before **October 20, 2020, 8:30 AM** to the BAC Secretariat in printed copy to be submitted at the *Procurement/BAC Office of Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital & Medical Center*.

Posting of Performance Security is required upon issuance of Notice of Award. Performance security shall be limited to **the following categories below that bidder may opt to use**, denominated in the Philippine Pesos and posted in favor of the Procuring Entity not less than the required percentage of the total contract price in accordance with the following schedule:

*In consideration of the limited access to financial institutions, regulatory and other offices, as well as the implementation of government restrictions on transport and travel, bidders are allowed to submit Performance Securing Declaration (PSD) in lieu of a performance security to guarantee the winning bidder's faithful performance of obligations under the contract, for procurement activities during a State of Calamity, or implementation of community quarantine or similar restrictions declared or being implemented either in the locality of the PE or of the Bidder, subject to the following **using the prescribed***

form:

- (a) Similar to the PSD used in Framework Agreement, such declaration shall state, among others, that the winning bidder shall be blacklisted from being qualified to participate in any government procurement activity for one (1) year, in case of first offense or two (2) years, if with prior similar offense, in the event it violates any of the conditions stated in the contract. A copy of the PSD form is attached hereto in Section VIII. BiddingForms;
- (b) An unnotarized PSD may be accepted, subject to submission of a notarized PSD before payment, unless the same is replaced with a performance security in the prescribed form, as stated above; and
- (c) The end-user may require the winning bidder to replace the submitted PSD with a performance security in any of the prescribed forms under Section 39.2 of the 2016 revised IRR of RA No. 9184 upon lifting of the State of Calamity, or community quarantine or similar restrictions, as the case may be. (**GPPB Resolution No. 09-2020**)

The Performance Security shall be valid until the issuance of the Certificate of Inspection and Acceptance Report by the Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital & Medical Center (MMMh&MC) which must form part of the terms and conditions of *the Bank draft/guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued by a Universal or Commercial Bank or Surety bond callable upon demand issued by a surety or insurance company duly certified by the Insurance Commission as authorized to issue such security* when opted to be used by the bidder. Otherwise, the award of contract shall be cancelled without prejudice of the institution of blacklisting proceeding or other administrative cases, civil or criminal cases with the forfeiture of the bid security.

Pursuant to Section 62.1 of the 2016 Revised Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act of 9184 a warranty security shall be required from the contract awardee for a minimum period of three (3) months, in case of Expendable Supplies, after acceptance by the Procuring Entity of the delivered supplies.

The Obligation for the warranty shall be covered by either retention money in an amount equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of every progress payment, or a special bank guarantee equivalent to at least one percent (1%) of the total contract price. The said amounts shall only be released after the lapse of the warranty period or, after the consumption thereof: Provided, however, that the supplies delivered are free from patent and latent defects and all the conditions imposed under the contract have been full met.

- 7. Bids shall be submitted in sealed envelopes preferably color **RED**, labelled as "Negotiation Documents", with the title of the procurement project, name of the Bidder, address of the Bidder and contact details of the bidder, addressed to the undersigned.
- 8. The Mariano Marcos Memorial Hospital and Medical Center (MMMh & MC) reserves the right to reject any and all bids, declare a failure of bidding, or not award the contract at any time prior to contract award in accordance with Section 41 of RA 9184 and its 2016 Revised IRR, without thereby incurring any liability to the affected bidder or bidders.
